Also to cook in the crock pot add 2 eggs and a can of tomato soup and turn on high for the first hour and 4 hours on low.

1/4 c. onion, diced

1/2 c. celery, diced

2 tsp. salt

1/4 tsp. poultry seasoning

4 eggs, beaten

2 c. chicken broth

Combine meat, rice, bread crumbs, onion and celery. Add salt, seasoning and broth to the eggs, stir in chicken mixture and mix thoroughly. Bake in greased 9x13 inch for 55 min. in 350 degree oven. May need a bit more broth, depending on dry appearance before baking. Cover pan with foil until last 10 min.

Sauce: Use broth mixed with mushroom soup. You may add a can of mushrooms.
