Registration is required by Feb. 29. Co-Parenting for Successful Kids (Parents Forever) is an educational program for all parents who are involved in divorce, custody modification, or who never married but are seeking custody. This program helps parents understand the impact of the divorce on their children and provides concrete actions that parents can take to help their children succeed through a divorce. Co-Parenting for Successful Kids classes meet the requirements of LB554.
